

In Genesis 1:3 we read, "And God said, 'Let there be light,' and there was light." Where there had been darkness, God brought light, and He did it simply by speaking. God's Word is powerful. God is able to change realities simply by His Word.

But we brought death and corruption into the good creation of God. Even so, our Lord has not abandoned us. He still gives us His Word. At times, that Word is painful for sinful man because God's Word points out our sin. And on account of the fact that it convicts us, we may want to avoid God's Word. But even when God convicts us, it is good for us. God identifies our sin so that we may recognize our very real need for His forgiveness and new life – just as a doctor diagnoses a disease before treatment.

And God's Word is far better than the treatment offered by any mortal man. In His Word, God proclaims to us the One in whom we have the forgiveness of sin. And that Word also authorizes the Church to forgive sin (see John 20:22-23). Sinners are reborn as His Word is connected to water and applied in Baptism. Sinners are given life as the living body and blood of Jesus is given under the forms of bread and wine for the forgiveness of sins.

In Isaiah 55:10-11, God gives a beautiful description of the power of His Word to create life, saying, "For as the rain and the snow come down from heaven and do not return there but water the earth, making it bring forth and sprout, giving seed to the sower and bread to the eater, so shall my word be that goes out from my mouth; it shall not return to me empty, but it shall accomplish that which I purpose, and shall succeed in the thing for which I sent it." God gives us a picture of the power of His Word by likening its effect to the Lutheran Church September 2022 News

effect of rain and snow on the earth. God's Word is not an empty, dead letter. God uses His Word to accomplish that which He desires.

God desires that you be saved from sin and death and the devil. He desires that you have new life, hope and peace. He desires that you live forever with Him. God accomplishes what He desires for you through His Word. In other words, the Word of God is good for you.

As Sunday School begins and as our Sunday morning Bible study returns to its regular time, I encourage you to hear God's Word there and in the Divine Service and also to read God's Word every day. Our Lord gives good gifts by His Word; these gifts are for you – for your eternal good because He loves you. Our Lord wants to bring light to darkness, forgiveness where there is sin, and new hope where there is despair. Come receive these good gifts this year! – Pastor Burfiend
